River Villages, Inc. - Oil Spill Response Team (OSRT)

The next quarterly Oil Spill training will be held June 15 - 21, 2008. It will be a special training called the PTA (Pipeline Training Academy). The Academy is set up for newer team members which enables them to become current on regulatory oil spill training and working requirements. Once it is taken, then all is needed is a yearly Refresher course that keeps team members up to date on the working requirements that would be needed while working on an actual oil spill.

If you are interested in getting involved with the OSRT Team, you must be 18 years of age, be able to pass mandatory pre-employment drug testing, be in good physical condition, and live in Fairbanks or Stevens Village. Please contact Howard Taylor or Maureen Mayo for more information.

Alaska Reclamation Inc. (ARI)

ARI, a subsidiary of Dinyee and RVI, is gearing up for the summer season and is now taking applications from within the Stevens Village and Dinyee family. ARI does residential, commercial, highway, and airport hydroseeding.

Qualifications:

- Be a tribal member of Stevens Village or shareholder of Dinyee or a family member of one. If you are a relation, make a note on the application who you are related to and what relation.
- Be at least 25 years old.
- Hold a current Alaska drivers license and have a clean driving record for the past 2 years. You will be required to submit a copy of your driving record prior to employment.
- PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE HAVING A CURRENT CDL AND HAVE EXPERIENCE DRIVING BIG TRUCKS.
- Be able to lift 50 lb. bags from floor level to shoulder level repeatedly over the course of a work day.
- Be able to read, understand and follow written instructions.
- Have reliable transportation to get to the worksite.
- Be available for work June 1 to October 31, six or seven days a week if needed.
- Pre-employment and random drug and alcohol testing required.

ARI has a contract with the Operating Engineers Local 302. All employees will be required to be a member of 302. Wage and benefit rates are negotiated annually with the Union. Currently we pay little Davis-Bacon wages where applicable. Non Davis-Bacon wages are currently \$21 per hour. ARI pays all union benefits directly to them and is in addition to the hourly wage.

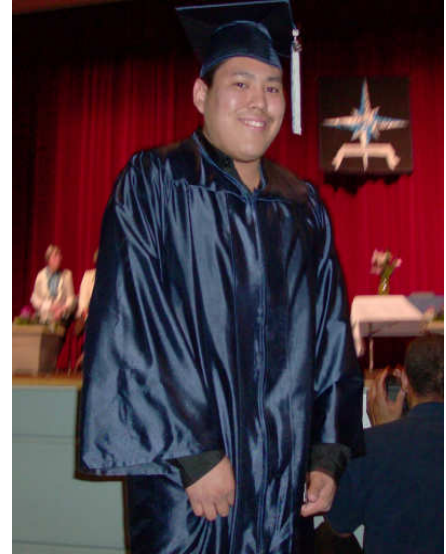
